Year 4 - Writing

I can read my own writing out loud using the right tone, volume and intonation.

I can propose changes to grammar and vocabulary to improve writing.

I can check that my writing makes sense and check for grammar mistakes.

I can sequence ideas logically and use simple organisational devices (e.g. headings, sub-headings)

I can create humour, suspense and atmosphere.
