

Year 1 - Writing

I can spell compound words.

I can use the graphemes up to phase 5 in my writing.

I can add "ing", "ed", "er", "est" to words

I can add "s" or "es" to words correctly.

I can spell the days of the week

I can write simple sentences that the teacher tells me

I can use "un" at the beginning of words.

I can say the letters of the alphabet in order

I can spell the first 44 words I have been taught in phonics

I can spell the first 30 words I have been taught in phonics

I can spell words with adjacent consonants.

I can segment words I hear and choose a grapheme to represent sounds
